#### **GAINC-RRIGC**

**Mandate:** To maintain the accountability and integrity of federal government departments and federally appointed judges, with transparency to the public

#### **Internal infrastructure:**

- Public relations
  - o Secure reception of information and tips
  - o Whistleblower protection
  - o Press releases, media events
  - o Reporting to the PMO
- Triage
  - o Assessment of the severity of impact of identified and suspected breaches of integrity and corruption
- Investigations
  - o Evidence collection and undercover operations
- Law enforcement interface
  - o Providing of evidence for arrests and prosecutions
- Human Resources
  - o Employee and prospective employee assessments
  - o Appropriately transparent disclosure to the public of employee assessments

GAINC will have the overwhelming task of identifying, investigating and aiding the prosecution of major breaches of ethics, integrity and corruption found within federally incorporated departments and among federally appointed judges. This will include all branches of the intelligence communities and police.

Those who wish to work for GAINC had better be prepared to submit to the most rigorous of holistic personality and behavioural assessments, and to have that information (where appropriate) disclosed to the public. Those tasked with maintaining the accountability and integrity of the nation will be subjected to the highest standards of ethics themselves.

Regular psychological evaluations and upgrading will be available to and necessary for all employees of GAINC.

Reports about the activities of GAINC will be disclosed to the public on a regular basis.

A dedicated subdivision of GAINC will accept comments, criticisms, tips regarding suspected breaches of integrity, suggestions for improvement.

GAINC will be the first line of defence against systemic corruption entering or overtaking our core social infrastructure.
